Look! Up in the Sky...



345 California Center is easily spotted on the San Francisco skyline with its two flag poles topping the building. Few people realize that there is a brave person who, when needed, climbs to the top of these flag poles. His name is Jim Phelan who works as a steeplejack, a person who climbs to the top of tall structures to perform maintenance or to make repairs. Jim first started working as a high steel worker and then transitioned his unique skill set to working on flag poles, riggings, and towers. Jim has been working with 345 California Center since the start of construction of the building in 1983 and has climbed our flag poles ever since. To get himself to the top of the pole Jim uses a system of pullies and slings to hoist himself. One sling harnesses him to the pole and one sling serves as a stirrup that he uses to push himself slowly to the top, one step at a time. Once at the top Jim replaces the pulley and then threads the new steel cable through the pulley. The steel cables are used to raise and lower the flags.
